Barbara and Jacob Moyer (1804-1882) started the Moyer Evangelical United Brethren Church by donating some of their farm land for the church and cemetery. Later their later years they live in Palmyra, PA. Barbara and Jacob had a daughter Anna Moyer who married Christian Brandt. Anna and Christian are Minnie Good's (1902-2000) parents. (Good, Minnie)

"In 1874 a piece of property consisting of 72 perches was deeded by Jacob and Barbara Moyer to The Moyer Church: Abram L. Brandt, Jacob L. Moyer and Samuel Garman, trustees of the Evangelical Association of North America. That same year the present church building was erected on this site." "In recent years additional land was given to the church for enlarging the cemetery so that the present property consist of four acres. Pending action by Eastern Pennsylvania Annual Conference this property will be maintained as a cemetery." (Moyers United Methodist Church, Bulletin. May 20, 1976) In 1946, the church was incorporated. (Members of Conewago Class, 1887-1957)
